My Xmas leave submission went in as soon as I heard that the bait was in the trench and with it, very good numbers of Marlin with a couple of boats doing well to get on them as soon as they arrived. Well known boat Tag & Brag went 6 from 11 in the height of it, and club local Scott got out in his boat Artemis and managed to tag a few with Smithy on the tail end of the run. I managed a trip out with Scott the day after with Ethan and Ryley with the hope of doing the same but were thwarted by Dolphins taking our live baits. I had never seen that before!

A few comps have been and gone since our last meeting. The Hervey Bay comp saw record numbers of fish and the Mooloolaba Billfish Bonanza has also been run with a good showing of 15 boats and 56 anglers. With summer here and plenty of pelagic species turning up we should be able to rack up some more numbers.

It is confirmed, next year Fishing Festival will be hosted by the Maryborough Sportfishing Club in October. As soon as we have the venue locked in, I will let you know so to book accommodation. Plenty of fishing options in that region. I always like to make a fishing holiday of it by going up the week before and sample all on offer. We moved to the Caboolture river and caught fish all day. Trolling the 67mm Jackal Squirrel (as in picture) was responsible for all the quality Flathead. There were heaps of boats out and a rising tide, but still managed to catch them by trolling the shallows. Well done to the Challenge committee organisers, they had some great prizes.

Weighmasters Report



Congratulations, to all that fished our clubs sportfishing competition, and club weekend. Club week offshore species were mahi-mahi none weighed, so jackpots next month. The inshore species were salmon, none weighed so will jackpot next month. The Other species won by Andrew Burke with a nice wahoo @ 8.3kg, just pipping Trevor Singleton who also weighed a wahoo at 8.25kg the weight adjusted to allow 10% of overall weight for gills /gut removed.

Well done Andrew Burke. Pending club record for 8kg and pending club record for all tackle length. Special mention to skipper of the vessel , Ya Rat , Doug Farrow, and Angler Chris Thomson capturing / weighing a Broadbill @ 63.8kg which is a pending club and QGFA Qld record. His fish was weighed outside a crowded deck at the club on a Friday afternoon, plenty of people taking photos and a lot of positive comments about the fish. The club scales have been certified and have been getting well used.

This month's club weekend fishing comp species are Wahoo \$150 and Bream \$100, club weekend being 16-18 December. Reminder club record all tackle length wahoo (at time of printing)– no record. Reminder club record all tackle length Bream is SM -460mm female- 360mm junior- 410

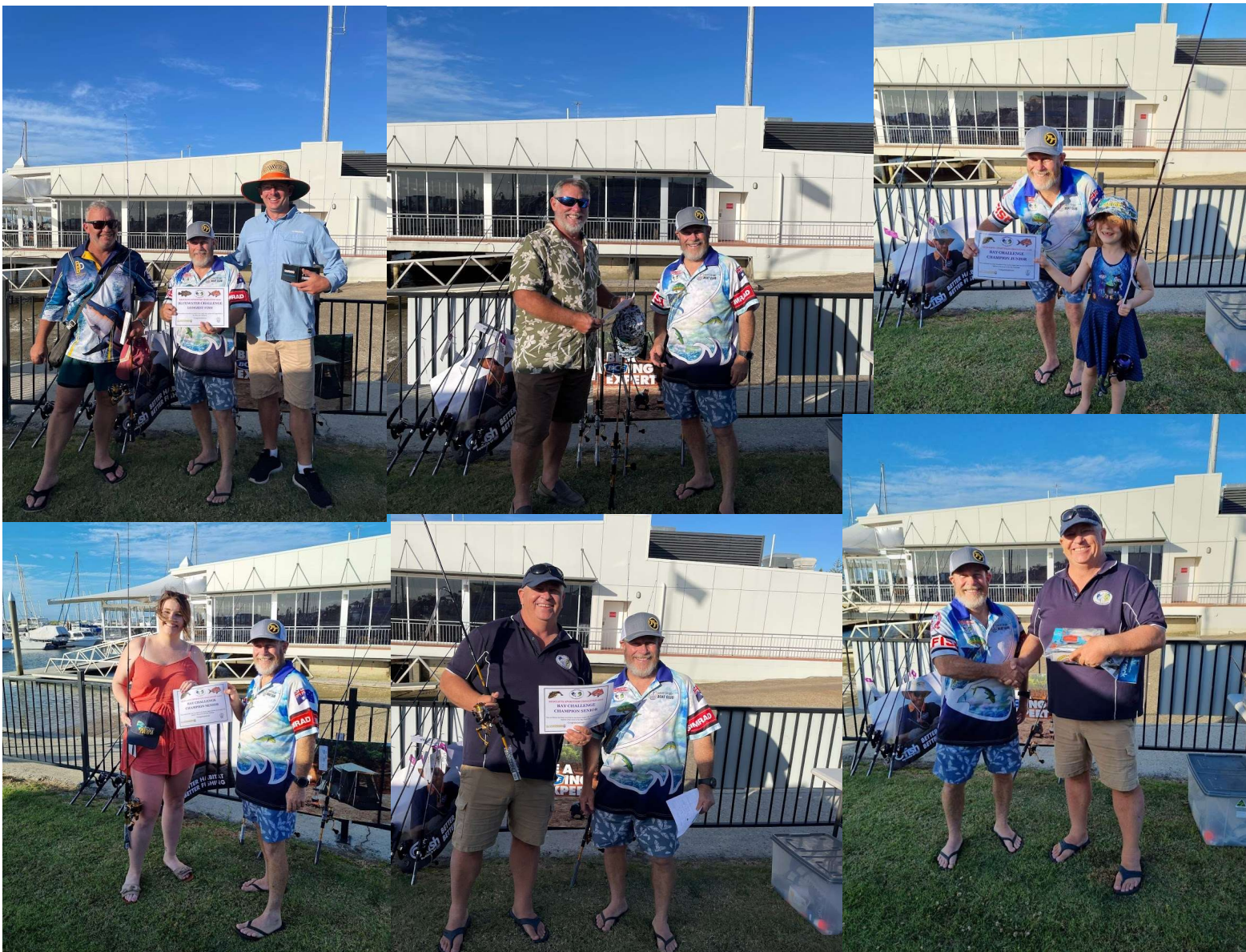
