Winner for the comp was Artemis captained by Scott Phillips who was fishing under Sunshine Coast with fellow sunny coaster George Bury and our very own Diego. I'm going to cross out Sunny Coast and replace it with Redcliffe on your form next year Scott. 🙏

Everything on the day went off without a hitch. It was practically a sell out crowd at the presentation dinner and the catering on both the Saturday and Sunday night was top notch (nice work leading the BBQ Greg). Great work all round from the tournament committee, Janine, the ground crew and again thanks to all our sponsors who make the magic happen. Special mention to Maddy who is a marvel when it comes to securing our sponsors. The count down begins to next years!

In other comp news, the Krolls fished the Bribie tournament and managed to take line honours with 2 striped marlin and a blue on day 2 after losing a black boat side on day 1. It was horrendous weather and shout out to my daughter Alyssa who managed her first billfish during it. The Sunshine Coast comp has been and gone with Artemis again fishing well with 2 blacks on day 1, but not enough to beat out the heavy tackle boats with White Noise winning the under 7.5m class and Virtue winning overall.

Billfish Babes out of Mooloolaba is next on calendar from the 10th to the 12th February, with a short break until Back to Tangas on the 3rd, 4th and 5th of March, and then finally Newport on the 11th and 12th of March. A reminder to everyone to support other clubs wherever you can, just as they support ours.

Finally, we need to lock down a date for the freshwater trip. I will throw two date options in the ring to kick things off, being the weekend of the 18th of March, or the weekend of the 1st of April. These two dates sit between the Newport comp which some of us will fish and the Easter holidays which we should work to avoid. Borumba was a clear favourite with the vote count on location, so let's work on that based on availability and numbers.

Champion Club status, we are still in 4th position with 39 species.

Next event on the ANSA calendar is the Statewide Species Challenge to be held on the May day Long weekend. There is no need to register for this event. The aim of this competition is to catch as many different species of fish over the weekend. It doesn't matter if you tag or bag your fish. The fish can be of any size, but you will need to take a picture and measure and submit. There is no obligation to compete for the full time. It is just meant to be some fun. I think Bundaberg won it last year.

After that, later in May, Sunshine Coast SFC will be hosting the STH QLD Interclub Challenge May 19th to 21st. This event will be run out of Carlo Point. Venue will be BIG4 Breeze Holiday Park. Some of our members have been here before and can provide an insight into accommodation and fishing options. Challenge is a club-based event, and our club is the defending champions. There are inshore, offshore and land-based fishing on offer. Full details should be on the ANSA events page very soon.

Fishing report - My son Sam has been fishing Kurwongbah Dam, near Petrie recently out of his kayak. This is a paddle only waterway and a SIPS is required. He has been catching good numbers of Saratoga up to 500. No big ones yet. Also, some Bass, all on frog surface lures casting to the lilly pads.

Just back from Monduran Dam chasing Barra for a few days, 10 Barra caught and released, and they were all in the 560 to 580mm range. Even at that size they still try to put up a fight. Best on field was the old favourite, the 100mm white slick rig. We caught them on several types. On arrival to the dam, the fishing reports all said it was tuff fishing, so we were happy to get a few. No big fish but, I did see a 103 caught by another bloke trolling mid-morning in the main basin. Fishing should improve further over the next couple of months.

Inshore report - There has been good numbers of snapper from the reefs in front of Redcliffe , still flathead to be found and the odd whiting. Spotty mackerel in the southern part of the bay
The billfish tournament held on the Australia day weekend was fantastic for all that entered, and a showpiece for the MBBC, I want to thank the tournament committee for organising an outstanding event and a special thanks to Gregg Evans and Vaughan Daly for taking on the extra duties of weighmaster so I could fish the tournament.

it was great to see the numbers of fish being caught and the number of boats entered. This is truly one of the premiere events for the QGFA and should be on everyone's bucket list!!

128 strikes, 85 hook-ups , 49 fish landed , 29 of these were black Marlin, 13 wahoo and 7 non-Qualifying fish.


