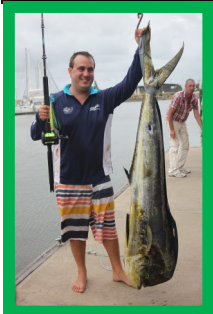

That weekend will also be the ANSA Queensland Species Challenge so if you choose to participate you can fish both at the same time. You will also need to register separately for the ANSA Species challenge at no cost if you are already an ANSA member. This is done online. I'm sure our ANSA delegate Greg Skinner will be able to assist members with registering and understanding the rules and technical stuff.

It is fantastic that we have new members regularly joining our club and I encourage the new members to not be shy - feel free to ask people their names, ask questions about the club, how it runs, fishing techniques and the different rules and so on. I have been involved with the club for many years now and I still don't know everything and everyone, so I am regularly seeking advice from the old hands.

In relation to Club Weekend Nominated Fish, just to be clear, you must weigh in your catch at club weigh-in on the Sunday to be eligible to claim the money prize for the Nominated Species. These rules were designed to encourage members and guests to attend the Club Weekend events.

Both nominated fish species are worth \$50 this month, so good luck. As usual 'sleepy' will have the BBQ firing.

Demonstration of Neptune's Treasures

At the March Club Night, the guys from Neptune's Treasures taxidermy came and presented Kiel Pozzey with his mounted, pending-record mahi mahi.

They explained about the processes they use, and the best way to preserve your fish so that it can be recreated in the most life-like way (wrapped in cling-film and frozen immediately).

They also endorsed tagging and releasing fish after taking the measurements and some clear photographs.

This allows you to release the fish unharmed, and from your pictures and measurements they can recreate an exact replica, allowing you to preserve the memory of that special fish of a lifetime.

ANSA Queensland Species Challenge 17-18th May 2014 Event Rules



AIM:

The ANSA Queensland Species Challenge is an event that reflects the fundamental challenge of fishing, that being the challenge of fisherman vs fish. The Challenge is instituted so that Anglers can join and fish together across Queensland over the same weekend. The only objective is catch as many different species from the ANSA Queensland species list as possible in two days.

This is the perfect event for kids and anglers seeking to challenge themselves beyond the traditional "catch the biggest/most fish".

NOMINATION:

Any person that registers online and pays for the challenge before the due date is eligible to enter. There is no requirement to be an ANSA member to enter. Non ANSA members will be granted temporary membership for the event as a part of the registration (which includes the temporary membership fee).

BOUNDARYS:

All fishing is to be conducted in Queensland waters.

HOURS OF EVENT:

The Challenge commences at 12.00 midnight on Friday and concludes at 2.00pm on Sunday of the weekend of the event.

TACKLE AND METHODS:

Any sportfishing tackle and/or method may be utilised.

NOTIFICATION OF RESULTS:

There will be three methods of reporting catches. Details of how to submit their catch will be provided to participants prior to the event start. Catches must be submitted by 6.00pm on the last day of the event.

1. During the day there will be a 1800 number that people can ring to record their entries and email in photos as confirmation each day.
2. Alternatively entries can be submitted online at the end of the day.
3. For ANSA members who tag fish, submitting a trip sheet and photos at the end of each day will also be an accepted method of entering species.

SCORING:

Anglers can register one fish of each species caught during the challenge. Anglers need to get a quick photo of the fish for identification if it is to be released. Fish may be kept or released if legal size. During the event there will be an online electronic scoreboard that tallies the results as they come in.

ELIGIBLE SPECIES:

Shall be only those species listed on the ANSA Qld website. A copy of the eligible species will be provided to all entrants.

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS:

The Challenge is essentially a social event and not a hard-fought competition. It is recognized however that those that meet the Challenge deserve recognition by their peers and so each category winner will receive a special Species Challenge commemorative lure.

The major prize winner will be selected by random draw from all participants who enter a fish during the challenge.

Awards shall be for the following:

- a) Individual Senior Male.
- b) Individual Senior Female.
- c) Individual Junior (10-16yrs)
- d) Individual Junior <10 Years

2014 RPG&SC Inc. Sportfishing Competition

"The underlying spirit of angling is that the skill of the angler is pitted against the instinct and strength of the fish and that the latter is entitled to an even chance for life."

This event aims to promote Sportfishing and encourage healthy competition between anglers in a friendly atmosphere. This event may be run in conjunction with RPG&SC club weekend and the A.N.S.A. Statewide Species Challenge.

Date: Saturday 17th and Sunday 18th May 2014.

Venue: Moreton Bay Boat Club, Bird O'Passage Parade, Scarborough. Under the sun shade on the grassed area or club deck if wet.

Cost: Seniors \$20 and juniors (under 16 years) are free (no cost).

Presentation: Approximately 4.30 pm Sunday after the weigh-in and the points are calculated.

Fishing Area: All waters between Double Island point and Qld/NSW Border including freshwater dams and rivers excluding privately owned waters.

Who Can Fish: The competition is open to all financial member of RPG&SC Inc or any other person who is a financial member of another fishing club affiliated with ANSA or QGFA, and registers for the competition.

Registration: Completed registration forms must be received by organisers prior to start fishing.

Weigh Station will be Open: 2.30pm to 4.30 pm Sunday only. No overtime permitted.

Fishing Times: Fishing commences at midnight Friday and fishing will cease at 3.30 pm Sunday.

Eligible Species: All fish species as per our eligible species list for ANSA.

Line Classes: You may use line classes – 2kg, 3kg, 4kg, 6kg, 8kg, 10kg, and 15kg.

Gilled & Gutted Fish: A 10% allowance will be given for cleaned fish, but no allowance will be made for Masters, State or National records.
