

Any member of a QGFA club that arranges such a tournament in direct competition to their Affiliated Club would also be acting against the best interest of their club and subject to disciplinary action according to the club's constitution. I would be disappointed in any individual who acted in a manner detrimental to an affiliated club and would support any club who disciplined a member for such action." Graeme Devin - QGFA President
