Members should be aware that both QGFA and GFAA will not recognise a record claim resulting from an unsanctioned tournament. I am also aware this is a cash prize tournament; this would also exclude any record claim. This tournament is not being arranged by a QGFA affiliated club and is not sanctioned or supported by QGFA. Any member of a QGFA club that arranges such a tournament in direct competition to their Affiliated Club would also be acting against the best interest of their club and subject to disciplinary action according to the club's constitution. I would be disappointed in any individual who acted in a manner detrimental to an affiliated club and would support any club who disciplined a member for such action." Graeme Devin - QGFA President

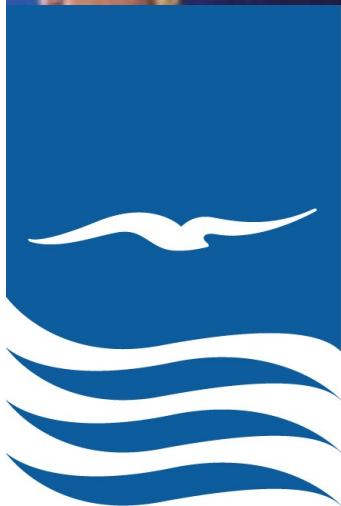

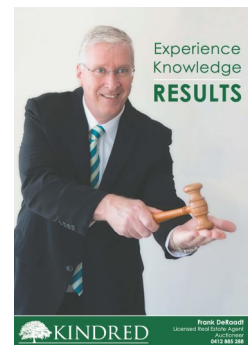
