

Chairman's Report

May 2015

Hi all

The nights are getting cooler but the fishing is still hot. The Snapper are biting in the bay and on the reefs. It has been a great year so far for targeting Mackerel. Pearl Perch, Amberjack and other reef fishing targets are starting to chew their heads off as the water cools. There are reports of small Black Marlin and Sailfish around, particularly off Mooloolaba while plenty of Blue Marlin are out in the deep waters ("Big Business" can validate this). So there are no excuses for not wetting a line this month.

This upcoming May Club weekend we will be running a Sportfish Competition. Sportfishing is the true test of angling skill and knowledge. Last year's winner was Rikki Ramsey, who fished the Brisbane River and caught a huge bag of Bream, Snapper, Flathead and Cod. To be involved you will need to register so we know who is fishing. We had a great turn out for the April Club Weekend. A few fish hit the scales. Ronnie Lewis weighed a nice Pearl Perch which was the nominated species. Congratulations to Bryce Trask for the tag and release of a beautiful Blue Marlin. Bryce is having a great year. Let's not forget Janine Cole, while fishing on "Little Wing" for Saltwater Kiwi Carp, she caught a nice Javelin Fish. I'm pretty sure it was Janine's first Javelin. If I remember right, John Eagle weighed a Flathead. Thanks to "Sleepy" Evan for cooking the BBQ.

Be aware that this is the last month we post the point scores leading up to the end of the fishing year on the 30th June. This will keep people guessing come trophy night.

2015 RPG&SC Sportfishing Competition

This is a Sportfishing Competition that may be run in conjunction with RPG&SC club weekend and the A.N.S.A. Statewide Species Challenge.

Date: Saturday 16th and Sunday 17th May 2015.

Venue: Moreton Bay Boat Club, Bird O'Passage Parade, Scarborough. Under the sun shade on the grassed area or on club deck if wet.

Cost: Seniors \$10 and juniors (under 16 years) are free (no cost).

Presentation time: Approximately 4.30 pm Sunday after the weigh-in and after the points are calculated.

Fishing Area: All waters between Double Island point and Qld/NSW Border including freshwater dams and rivers excluding privately owned waters.

Who Can Fish: The competition is open anyone who is a financial member of ANSA or QGFA, and registers for the competition with competition organisers prior to start fishing.

Weigh Station will be Open: 3.30pm to 4.30 pm Saturday and 3.30pm to 4.30pm Sunday.

Fishing Times: Midnight Friday and fishing will cease at 3.30 pm Sunday.

Eligible Species: All fish species as per our eligible species list for ANSA.

Line Classes: you may use line classes - 1kg, 2kg, 3kg, 4kg, 6kg, 8kg, 10kg, and 15kg.

Gilled & Gutted Fish: A 10% allowance will be given for cleaned fish, but no allowance will be made for Masters, State or National records.

Fishing Rules: This competition is conducted under ANSA rules for Division 1 Sportfishing and Division 2 Lure casting. All State and Federal Fishing Regulations and bag limits must be observed.

What Can You Weigh: Each Angler can weigh up to a maximum of 5 fish of each species per day (within fishing regulations).

How are Points calculated: Capture points are calculated as per the ANSA formula. (Fish weight kg) \times 100 \times fighting factor and then divided by line class = points. Tag points as per the table.

Fish Identification: Please ensure all fish presented to the weigh master are labelled with the angler's initials, line class and division.

Line Types: As per the ANSA regulations. Braid may be used by fishing with "breakaway trace". The breakaway trace must be a minimum of 500mm long and a maximum 1000mm in length. The main line must be at least one strain heavier than the breakaway trace

Trophy categories: 2015 SPORTFISHING CHAMPION

Highest point scoring senior – Tag & Release. Highest point scoring senior – Capture Highest point scoring junior – Tag & Release. Highest point scoring junior – Capture Highest point scoring fish - Tag & Release.

2KG Trophy – For the heaviest fish captured on 2kg line.

BBQ: There will be a free BBQ provided on Sunday for the weigh-in and presentation. Alcoholic beverages may be purchased from the MBBC bar.

Please Note: While RPG&SC Inc. takes all due care when conducting events ,the RPG&SC Inc. and the MBBC are not liable for any damage, injury or costs sustained to persons or property, therefore all persons participating in RPG&SC Inc. events must conduct themselves in a responsible manner.

To Register: Complete registration form and forward to Treasurer John Schulte or email details to Noel Day prior to start fishing at midnight Friday.

Guiding Information: Combination Main line and Breakaway line.

Breakaway Line must be (min 0.5M – max 1.0M). Main line must be at least 1 class heavier than the Breakaway trace. The use of a double/leader/trace is optional. When a breakaway line is used in conjunction with a main line the entire combined line will be accepted by ANSA at the breaking strain of the breakaway line for all Divisions and Records (Line Class) and Masters Awards. Existing criteria for the combined length of doubles, leaders and traces will be as per ANSA Rule Book.

Main Line Knot/swivel Breakaway Line Knot/swivel Double/ leader/trace

POINT SCORE CALCULATING FORMULA:

(MASS (kg) x 100 x Factor) Divided by LINE CLASS (kg)) = Points

The factor shall be taken from the list of Eligible Species.

Example of Point Score Calculation: Capture: Flathead (Factor 1. 0)

Line Class: 2kg line class

Weight: 2.9

Points: (2. 9 x 100 x 1. 0) divided by 2. 0 = 145

ANSA State-wide Species Challenge

AIM: The ANSA Queensland Species Challenge is an event that reflects the fundamental challenge of fishing, that being the challenge of fisherman vs fish. The Challenge is instituted so that Anglers can join and fish together across Queensland over the same weekend. The only objective is catch as many different species from the ANSA Queensland species list as possible in two days.

This is the perfect event for kids and anglers seeking to challenge themselves beyond the traditional "catch the biggest/most fish".

NOMINATION: Any person that registers online and pays for the challenge before the due date is eligible to enter. There is no requirement to be an ANSA member to enter. Non ANSA members will be granted temporary membership for the event as a part of the registration (which includes the temporary membership fee).

BOUNDARYS: All fishing is to be conducted in Queensland waters.

HOURS OF EVENT: The Challenge commences at 12.00 midnight on Friday and concludes at 2.00pm on Sunday of the weekend of the event.

TACKLE AND METHODS: Any Sportfishing tackle and/or method may be utilised.

NOTIFICATION OF RESULTS: There will be three methods of reporting catches. Details of how to submit their catch will be provided to participants prior to the event start. Catches must be submitted by 6.00pm on the last day of the event.

- 1. During the day there will be a mobile number people can phone or text their entries to.
- Alternatively entries can be submitted online at the end of the day.
- For ANSA members who tag fish, submitting a trip sheet and photos at the end of each day will also be an accepted method of entering species.

SCORING: Anglers can register one fish of each species caught during the challenge. Anglers need to get a quick photo of the fish for identification if it is to be released. Fish may be kept or released if legal size. During the event there will be an online electronic scoreboard that tallies the results as they come in.


