

Dr Julian Pepperell gave an excellent talk on tagging billfish at the last meeting.

To win the money for the monthly nominated fish inshore or offshore species, simply weigh in the heaviest **Mackerel** or **Cod**. All fish weighed, regardless of whether they are in for the 'fish of the month' must be labelled with the angler's name and line class. To receive double club points, fish must be tagged or caught on the Club Weekend only and the cards correctly completed and handed in or fish weighed in at M.B.B.C. from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the Sunday. Prizes for the heaviest 'fish of the month' will be awarded at the following club night.

Remember, club fishing weekend starts on midnight on Friday **12th February** finishing on **Sunday 14th February** at 3.30-4.30pm and the species are **Mackerel** and **Cod**. The next **Club Meeting** will be held on **Tuesday 9th February at 7.30pm**.

## 2016 Australia Day Tournament Report

February 2016

Registration and Briefing on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> January was well attended and the sponsors given a big welcome and thanks from Chairman Greg Skinner. Weather Forecasts were tossed around and everyone was keen to make the most of it.

134 Anglers, including 13 Lady Anglers and 4 Junior Anglers in 29 boats patronised the Brisbane Marine sponsored event, held out of the very well-appointed Moreton Bay Boat Club.

DAY 1 and the weather ~~was~~ somewhat detrimental to comfort, and the fishing started slow until the turn of the tide. By the 13:00 sked, there were well over 40 strikes to produce 4 Black Marlin tagged and some Spanish Mackerel, Dolphin Fish, Tuna and a Wahoo. As the afternoon wore on the 'other species' numbers grew with a Cobia was added along with various 'vermin' that included a Sea Snake and sizeable Long Tom!

All gear checks passed the requirements, though there were some disappointed anglers because their Spanish Mackerel did not make line class at the scales.

A very enjoyable evening ensued with another great Dinner from the MBBC kitchen!

DAY 2 showed an increase in comfort levels; however it seemed that the fish had been located on the first day and there was still a lot of activity in *Power Comm*, and many remained there with a good supply of bait. During the day it was the Spanish Mackerel that took over the strike rate again.

At Stop Fishing Day 2 there were an additional 3 Black Marlin and 1 Striped Marlin, along with a Long Tailed Tuna that ended up the heaviest of the 'other species', weighing in at 12.5kg.

Probably the biggest fish hooked in the Tournament was a Marlin estimated at 110kg which was quickly set free to join his mates out wide. A Mako Shark also joined the Tournament for a short time. And on the Shark side of things, there were some Mackerel that did not make the ice box.

So, at the end of a very well organised and run Tournament there were 122 Strikes, 61 hook-ups and 43 fish recorded. That included 8 Black Marlin and 1 Striped Marlin; 11 Spanish Mackerel and 2 Spotted Mackerel, 1 Long Tailed Tuna, 1 Yellowfin Tuna, 2 Striped Tuna and 1 Mac Tuna, 1 Wahoo, 2 Dolphin Fish and 7 NQ species including Long Tom, carefully returned.

Judging by the happy faces at the presentation with another great dinner, the Tournament was a huge success, and sponsors were acknowledged again. Thank you to all for your co-operation at all times and a big thanks to the Redcliffe Coast Guard for their co-operation.

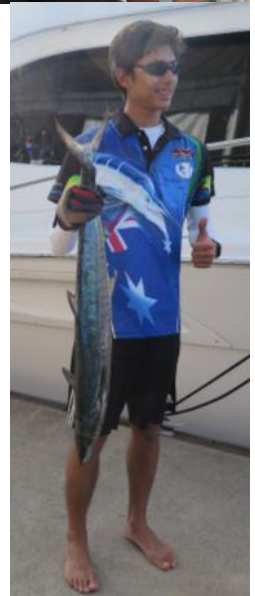
