

To receive double club points, fish must be tagged or caught on the Club Weekend only and the cards correctly completed and handed in or fish weighed in at M.B.B.C. from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the Sunday. Prizes for the heaviest 'fish of the month' will be awarded at the following club night.

## Tagging Fish

April 2016

It's important to remember the number 1 reason we tag fish is for research, not just to gain points.

Taking this into consideration it is of the utmost importance that when we tag a fish, **all** the information must be recorded and submitted to the weigh master or recorder.

### **Tagging Game fish:**

Once you tag a gamefish you must record the information onto a Q.G.F.A. Boat/Angler Activity Record sheet along with a Club Capture sheet. If you don't have one of these booklets please ask Ralph (our Weigh Master) or Noel (Recorder) for one as these as they **must** be submitted with the tag cards. If we as a club don't provide the information we will not be given extra tags from Q.G.F.A.

### **Tagging Sportfish:**

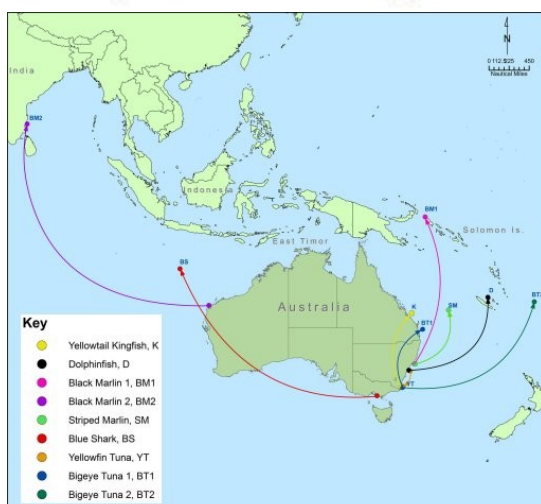
Once you have tagged a sportfish **all** the information should be recorded onto a Suntag sheet along with a Club Capture sheet and submitted to the Weigh Master or Recorder. Once again if you require assistance please ask Ralph (Weigh Master) or Noel (Recorder).

### **Tags:**

If you require tags please see Ralph, he keeps a stock on hand and is just a phone call away.

When filling out your capture sheet etc. please make sure that **all** the information is filled out so the appropriate points can be allocated to you.

**Please NOTE** when fishing in other tournaments keep you tag cards so they can be submitted by our club to Q.G.F.A., and keeping in mind you will still need to fill out a club capture sheet and QGFA sheet.

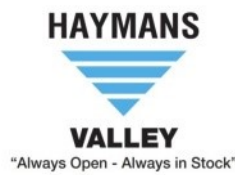

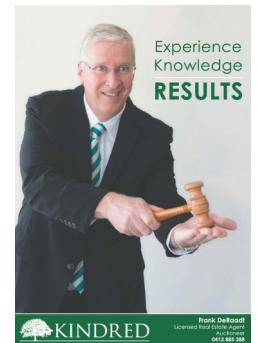
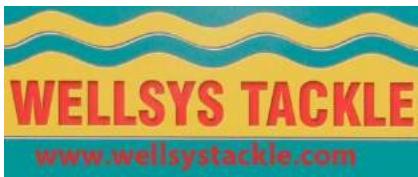
