

**June 2016**

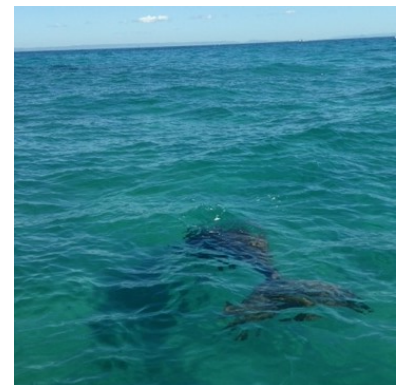

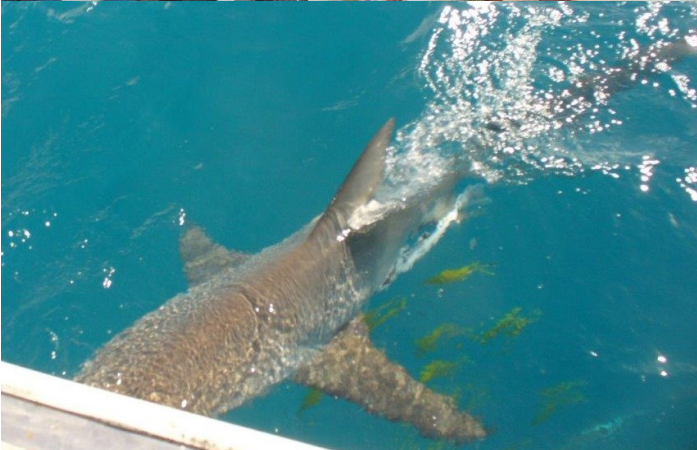

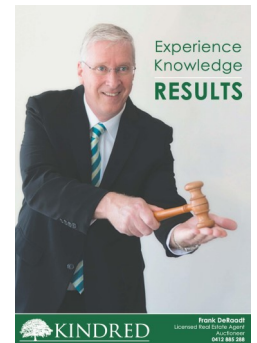
