

To receive double club points, fish must be tagged or caught on the Club Weekend only and the cards correctly completed and handed in or fish weighed in at M.B.B.C. from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the Sunday. Prizes for the heaviest 'fish of the month' will be awarded at the following club night.

Remember, club fishing weekend starts on midnight on Friday **12th July** finishing on **Sunday 13th July** with a weigh-in and barbeque at 3.30-4.30pm and the species are **Pearl Perch** and **Bream**. The next **Club Meeting (and AGM)** will be held on **Tuesday 9th July at 7.30pm**.

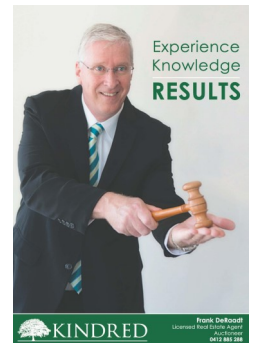
