The Redcliffe All Tackle Tournament is a Q.G.F.A. sanctioned light and heavy tackle tournament, hosted by the Redcliffe Peninsula Game & Sportfish Club Inc. Venue will be the Moreton Bay Boat Club - Bird O'Passage Parade, Scarborough, QLD.

Thursday 17th Nov. Registration & Briefing - 6.30pm at MBBC

Saturday 19th Nov. Fishing - 7am to 4pm – No requirement to return to port

Sunday 20th Nov. Fishing - 6am to 2pm, followed by 6.30pm Dinner & Presentation at MBBC

#### Tournament Entry Cost

\$150.00 per adult angler (over 16 years of age)

\$50.00 per junior angler (under 16 years of age)

(Entry fee will cover anglers who will receive a tournament shirt, Red fees, nibbles on briefing night and buffet dinner at the Sunday evening presentation).

#### Entry

Entry forms must be received by the Tournament Committee prior to the start of the Briefing. There will be a CASH early entry prize of \$300.00, done as a lucky draw prior to the start of Briefing for boats registered and paid by midnight on Wednesday the 9<sup>th</sup> of November.



# REDCLIFFE ALL TACKLE TOURNAMENT

## Memberships

All anglers must be current financial members of a club affiliated with G.F.A.A. or Q.G.F.A and proof of membership may be required. Membership must be organised prior to Briefing Night.

## Trophies and Prizes

CHAMPION BOAT & CREW, OVER 7 METRES \$1,000 Cash + Trophy

CHAMPION BOAT & CREW Under 7 METRES, \$1,000 Cash + Trophy

CHAMPION MALE, FEMALE & JUNIOR, \$300 Cash each + Trophy

FIRST BILLFISH TAGGED, \$250 Cash

LAST BILLFISH TAGGED, \$250 Cash

HIGHEST SCORING OTHER SPECIES, \$250 Cash

CHAMPION TWO-BOAT TEAM, \$100 Cash each per team member (max. 6 per boat) + Medallions

JUNIOR PARTICIPATION AWARDS

## Lucky Angler Prize

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>

All anglers that register before midnight on the 9<sup>th</sup> November 2016 will go into the Lucky Angler Draw.

## Briefing

It is expected that at least one member of each team will attend the Briefing and Calcutta on Briefing Night.

## Home ports

Boats may depart and return to any port each day of the tournament.

## Calcutta

The Calcutta will be determined by highest point scoring boats overall. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.

## Fishing Grounds

Fishing grounds will be between lines directly East of Point Cartwright to a line directly East of Point Lookout and all oceanic waters in between.

## Weather and Breakdowns

No allowance will be made for fishing time lost during bad weather or breakdowns. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel or postpone fishing due to bad weather at any time. In regard to anglers' entry fees, arrangements will be made if the tournament is cancelled or postponed.

## Nominated Teams Event

Tournament organisers will randomly draw teams of 2 boats for the Teams Event on Briefing Night. In the case of an odd number of boats, the last boat drawn will be teamed up with another randomly drawn boat. The team with the highest combined score will be awarded the Champion Two-boat Team.

## Presentation

Each angler must be present at the Presentation if they are to receive a prize or trophy.

## Radio Skeds

Competing boats must have VHF radio and skippers must keep radio sked sheets. Skeds will be on VHF21 at 10.03am, 1.03pm and 3.03pm for Saturday (Day 1) and at 10.30am and 1.03pm for Sunday (Day 2). Boats are to report name, grid position, strikes, hook ups, tags or captures, angler's name and species to the Game Fish Base. A penalty may apply for failure to respond to skeds. 1st Billfish tagged MUST be called in immediately.

## Boat Length

For the purpose of the tournament, boat length overall to be determined from the measurement taken from the bow (excluding bowsprit) to the stern (excluding outboard pods). This measurement will be used to determine 7 metres and under, or over 7 metres.

## Weigh-in

The weigh-in will be conducted at Moreton Bay Boat Club, Scarborough.

On day 1 - Saturday: Weigh station will be open between 4.30pm and 6.30pm.

On day 2 – Sunday: Weigh station will be open between 2.30pm and 4.30pm.

Fishing caught on Day 1 may be weighed-in on Day 2 but must be in reasonable condition. Decaying fish will not be accepted by the Weighmaster for weighing. Fish possession limits must be adhered to.

Tag cards for billfish tagged on Day 1 may be handed to Weighmaster at the Day 2 weigh-in.

No points will be recorded unless capture forms are filled in correctly for both tagged and captured fish. To receive points, each angler must present their capture forms, tag cards and captures to the Weighmaster in person and must remain with the Weighmaster during weighing and recording. There will be a limit of three fish of any one species per angler per day that may be weighed.

No fish are to be left at the weigh station and all unwanted fish must be disposed of in the correct manner. Points will be deducted for any infringements.

## Tag & Release Points

Tag points will be allocated to BILLFISH only.

Tag points will be allocated as per this table					
Inside 100 metre line			Outside 100 metre line		
6KG	8KG	10KG	24KG	37KG	60KG
1000	950	900	1800	1700	1600



Only NSW DPI and GFAA approved billfish tags are to be used, failure to use the correct tags will result in zero points being allocated. It is the responsibility of each competing boat to provide their own tags.

#### **Capture Points**

Capture points are calculated as follows: Fish weight multiplied by 100 divided by line class.

Fish may be dressed and a 10% allowance will be made. However potential record claims must be presented intact.

#### **Other species**

A limit of 3 fish of any one species per angler per day. Any fish to weigh must be equal to or greater than line class.

Eligible Species include, Yellowfin Tuna, Longtail Tuna, Spanish Mackerel, Mahi Mahi, Cobia, Wahoo and Snapper.

#### **Boat Insurance**

All boats nominating to fish the Redcliffe All Tackle are required to have current boat insurance. Details of such insurance must be completed on the Tournament entry form.

#### **FISHING RULES**

1. Each team will consist of no more than 6 and no less than two anglers.

2. There will be two line categories:

Light tackle 6kg, 8kg and 10kg only inside the 100 metre line.

Heavy tackle 24kg, 37kg and 60kg only outside the 100 meter line.

Game base must be notified when changing line categories.

3. A maximum of two rods per angler only at any one time, except when live baiting.

4. Live baiting - one rod per angler to be used and cannot be handled by others.

5. No live bait capture is permitted prior to commencement of fishing on day one.

6. Each angler to receive equal fishing opportunity.

7. Skippers may manoeuvre boat to assist anglers.

8. Boat crew are not permitted to assist in any way other than to tag and release or capture the fish as per G.F.A.A rules. Points apply when tag is inserted.

9. Hook ups that go into overtime are only permitted on the Saturday and must be reported to game base prior to cease fishing. Game base is to be updated on progress when requested.

10. The only "other species" eligible for weighing are Yellowfin Tuna, Longtail Tuna, Spanish Mackerel, Mahi Mahi, Cobia, Wahoo and Snapper. Capture must be equal to or greater than line class. A weigh limit of 3 of any one species per angler per day will apply.

11. In the event of a tie, the first to attain the total score will be deemed as the winner.

12. The Tournament Committee will decide all trophy and category winners. The Club reserves the right to review the awarding of any trophy.

13. An angler must submit any protests relating to the competition in writing no later than one hour after the close of the weigh-in on the day of the alleged infringement. Any decision of the Tournament Committee is final.

14. Fishing area limits will be as per grid sheet supplied at the Briefing Night. All vessels must log on and off with game fish base. In the event of a vessel returning early, they must notify game fish base. Boats logging off for the day are deemed to have ceased fishing for that day.

15. Boat skipper or team captain must sign registration and waiver form on behalf of crew as part of their entry to the tournament.

16. Q.G.F.A Rules and Regulations and Queensland Fisheries restrictions apply.

#### **Fuel and Berths**

Fuel and ice will be available (details on Briefing Night). The MBBC Marina berths will be available to competitors on request.

#### **Amenities**

There are amenities available at the club including showers. Ice is available from the club bar.

#### **Boat Insurance**

All boats nominating to fish the Redcliffe All Tackle are required to have current boat insurance. Details of such insurance must be completed on the Tournament entry form.

#### **Misconduct**

The Tournament Committee reserves the right at any stage of the competition to disqualify or deduct points from individuals or teams who are deemed to have conducted themselves in a disrespectful manner and are deemed to have brought the sport of gamefishing or the RPG&SC Inc. or the Moreton Bay Boat Club (MBBC) into disrepute. MBBC licensing regulations must be observed including appropriate dress codes, alcohol restrictions and noise limits. Alcohol that is opened on the boat must be consumed on the boat while docked at MBBC. MBBC staff must be respected and directions followed.

**No thongs in the club after 7pm. Please bring shoes.**

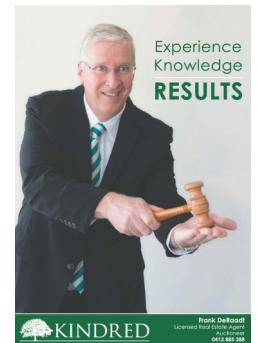
