

To win the money for the monthly nominated fish inshore or offshore species, simply weigh in the heaviest **Sweetlip** or **Bass**. All fish weighed, regardless of whether they are in for the 'fish of the month' must be labelled with the angler's name and line class. To receive double club points, fish must be tagged or caught on the Club Weekend only and the cards correctly completed and handed in or fish weighed in at M.B.B.C. from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the Sunday. Prizes for the heaviest 'fish of the month' will be awarded at the following club night.

Remember, club fishing weekend starts on midnight on Friday 12th May, finishing on Sunday 14th May with a weigh-in and barbeque at 3.30-4.30pm. Make sure you take a photo at the time of any capture-and-releases on club weekend and email it to the Recorder (currently noelday@optusnet.com.au) for verification.
