

Two boats (Over It & Liquid Asset) fished the 2017 Whitsunday light tackle tournament in October. A total of 36 boats entered from memory ranging from 17 foot trailer boats to large game boats. The weather was lovely and the shotgun start a great spectacle out the front of Shute Harbour. As expected, local knowledge was invaluable. This event does not require tagging and several species count for points even if not line class (mackeral, tuna, cobia, mahi mahi etc).

Most boats found the tuna, generally northern blue fin or yellow fin, but the billfish were more of a challenge to locate. Several were recorded, with a few sailfish. Unfortunately the Liquid Asset team had to retire at about 10.30am on day one and withdraw - the problem seemed to be monkeys in the engine room (photo attached). A big thanks to Steve and the crew on Over It for taking the Liquid Asset team on board for day two, it certainly beat sitting on the dock emptying the eskies. Day one saw both Redcliffe boats bag the 6 tuna needed, with yellowfin and mackeral to Over It. Day two saw Over It among the Tuna again and unfortunately drop a black marlin. Day three saw no more billfish action for our lads.

In line with our captures we didn't take the trophies but thoroughly enjoyed the event. A great location around the islands without having to travel long distances to fish and a friendly bunch of locals. The Calcutta was both enthusiastic and hilarious. Pete Distel, as skipper of Liquid Asset, was handed the encouragement award - the locals were just as disappointed as we were that we couldn't continue on. A big thanks also to Ash Warland for his assistance in arranging a top local diesel mechanic.

One notable capture was a black marlin weighing an estimated 700 to 800lb on a 17ft Haines trailer boat by a female crew member, a fair effort on stand-up gear and 10kg line.

Over It has safely made passage back to Redcliffe, Liquid Asset is on her way at the time of

writing this report.
