

To win the money for the monthly nominated fish inshore or offshore species, simply weigh in the heaviest **Mackeral** or **Cod.** All fish weighed, regardless of whether they are in for the 'fish of the month' must be labelled with the angler's name and line class. To receive double club points, fish must be tagged or caught on the Club Weekend only and the cards correctly completed and handed in or fish weighed in at M.B.B.C. from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the Sunday. Prizes for the heaviest 'fish of the month' will be awarded on the day so you must be there. Remember, club fishing weekend starts on midnight on **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February** finishing on **Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> January** at 3.30pm.

### February 2020

#### **Borumba & Lenthalls Trip**

Early January this year I made the trip to Borumba Dam near Imbil with my long time fishing mate Macca from Coffs Harbour.

Macca needed to tick a Saratoga off his bucket list.

We couldn't raise a Toga on a lure so we decided to try some baits under a float. We used steak, but you can use almost anything like

prawn, chicken, liver or worms. It didn't take long and we had tagged and released two Toga. 51and a 55cm, then headed back to the ramp.

On the way back we ran into Brendan, Carl and a few ANSA members from Sunshine Coast on their monthly comp. They did a bit better than us with some fish over 70cm long after a slow start.





Next part of the trip was Lenthalls Dams just east of Maryborough. We started with a quick troll as a bit of a recon and quickly boated two good Bass. There were Bass everywhere on the sounder. Over the next 3 sessions we boated 4 Barra in the 50 cm range. All on soft plastics cast to laydown timber

or weed banks in 2 to 3 metres of water.



Note that Lenthalls dam you can only have a boat with a four stroke or EFI motor 60HP or under. And a max speed of 6 knots. Pick of the lures was a Castair Jerky J rigged weedless.
