Club Championship update, 24 species different species submitted to date, and we are in 3rd position.

You can now register for the Boondooma Fishing Festival. Kingaroy are also organising a Bus Tour of the region on the Saturday for any non-fishing folk if they get enough interest. I believe they plan to visit historical sites, have a lunch stop, and end up at a winery. More details to come. All members are invited to the festival. It is always wonderful to get out bush. Boondooma is about 3 and a half hours west. Just up the road. About 29 people registered at last count. Although the Festival officially starts on the Friday, many of us will be arriving earlier in the week just because we can. I always suggest a couple of days pre-fishing and pre-drinking.

At the AGM there will be positions up for grab if you are looking to get involved in the state executive committee. Bob Dover who looks after tagging and Matt Leavy who does promotions are stepping back for now at this stage.

If you have tagged any fish, please make the effort, and submit the tagging information, otherwise you have put a hole in the fish for no reason. It is also disappointing for someone to catch a tagged fish only to find out there are no details. I have experienced this. Just a reminder that QLD Sportfishers have introduced a Landbased division to the All-Tackle Length Only records. The guidelines can be found on the website.

Fishing reports – There are still plenty of Flathead around the usual spots like the Pine River and Ningi Creek. It has been a very consistent season for them.

From some reports I have seen, Somerset Dam is worth a fish again. The dam was recovering from the floods. Dirty water, low oxygen levels and a widespread fish kill. I haven't fished it myself, but it should continue to improve as the water warms up.

A quite month of fishing for me. I will try to do better next month.

"Heaviest Other Species" Not Claimed - ask Mick King about that
September club fishing weekend starts Friday 16th 4.30pm till Sunday 18th at 4.30pm
Nominated Species are Snapper and whiting, and a cash prize for heaviest other species
Whiting have been plentiful around the mouth of Caboolture River and near Deception Bay. I've been fishing from the shore at Maroochy River and caught the odd summer whiting last week. There's also been plenty of Quality Snapper around the front of Scarborough, Margate, and Woody Point.

REMINDER: Snapper Club record for all tackle length is 480mm for senior male and 660mm for Junior, currently no senior female records.

There will be a prize for junior all tackle- length only for summer whiting, 310mm and winter whiting currently no junior record for trumpeter whiting

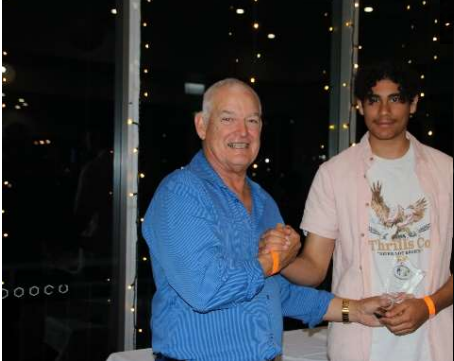
