## Hi Fishos,

Champion Club status, we are still in 4th position with 46 species. Next event on the ANSA calendar is the Statewide Species Challenge to be held on the Mayday Long weekend. There is no need to register for this event. The aim of this competition is to catch as may different species of fish over the weekend. It doesn't matter if you tag or bag your fish. The fish can be of any size, but you will need to take a picture and measure and submit capture on the ANSA website.

After that, later in May, Sunshine Coast SFC will be hosting the STH QLD Interclub Challenge May 19th to 21st . This event will be run out of Carlo Point. Venue will be BIG4 Breeze Holiday Park. Challenge is a club-based event, and our club is the defending champions. There are inshore, offshore and land-based fishing on offer. Visit the events page to register. You need to book you own accommodation and mention you are with ANSA Interclub.

The Maryborough Fishing Festival will be based at the Wallace Caravan Park, Ferry St Maryborough. Date from September 29th to October 1st . I usually get there earlier in the week to sample the fishing options. Barra and King Salmon can be caught within 500 metres of the park. Book your accommodation early.

Fishing report - Recently headed up to Villeneuve at the top of Somerset dam to tag Saratoga and end up with 2 from 4 hook ups on bait which is pretty good. A 47 cm and a 43 cm but dropped the biggest which would have been about 70 cm . I need to put more time in there.

Sam King and I finished in 4th place in Tagatoga. Over the 4 fishing sessions we caught one Yellowbelly at $45 \mathrm{~cm}, 13$ Bass to 38 cm and 11 Toga to 76 cm . Most of the Toga were caught on baits under a float but 2 were caught of lures. Best lures, a white Jackall TN60 and a $1 / 4$ TT Vortex spinnerbait in baby Bass colour. Altogether, there was 113 Toga caught with the biggest going 79 cm .

Note: Monduran Dam is still firing for Barra and more of the bigger models are starting to bite. This hot fishing should continue.

Congratulations, to all that fished our club weekend.

The weather a little rough on Saturday around 15-20 knots, Sunday was $10 \mathrm{knt} \mathrm{N} / \mathrm{E}$ The Sunday afternoon BBQ was well attended , and as always great to catch up with the crew. The offshore species were Cobia /Kingfish, nothing weighed so jackpots to $\$ 300$. The inshore species for December were cod , nothing weighed so jackpots to \$150. The other species ( heaviest ) - nothing weighed but remains at \$50.

This month's club weekend fishing comp species are Tuna @ \$300 and Whiting @ \$150, club weekend being Friday $10^{\text {th }}$ starting at 4 pm and finishing at the weigh in on Sunday 12th at 430pm.

Reminder club record all tackle length for whiting - 310mm.

Offshore report - while the run of marlin seems to have dropped off a few still being caught around the sunshine coast and good numbers on the gold coast. Dollies being caught around the fad N/E of Hutchies and off Stradbroke Island

Inshore - There are lots of mackerel in the bay at the moment, try trolling a spoon around the 6metre line at the front of Redcliffe, you might be surprised.
