. Hi Fishos,

The ANSA S.E QLD Interclub Challenge was run last month up at Carlo Point. Hosted by the Sunshine Coast Club. The event was attended by 51 members from 4 different clubs. Our club only had 4 fishos having a crack, and we finished in third place behind Sunny Coast. Kingaroy SC took the big Trophy home to the bush. Shaun Manthey and crew caught a heap of fish offshore. The fishing was very good up there with plenty of fishing options, and the boats that went offshore caught some very nice fish. I mostly targeted the Flathead (again). From half tide out, there were many good-looking gutters with Flathead siting in the shallows. Biggest I got was 582mm. A white 3" paddle tail Z-man on ¼ jig head did the trick for me. The BIG4 where we stayed was next to the boat ramp and there was plenty of room. The host for next years event has not been determined yet.

In the Club Championship we are in 4th place with 69 species. We are almost at the end of the fishing year, so please submit any outstanding tagging details. Great to see Jesse Harbourne getting out fishing regularly contributing many species.

Next ANSA event is the Fishing Festival to be held a Maryborough, on the October long weekend.

Fishing report – I got about good size 15 squid in the Bribie Passage, all on 95mm Zerek Fishtrap lure in Fat Betty color. I use these lures so I can target fish at the same time and the squid nail them. The morning high tide was the best bite.






