#### **August Report**

Hi Fishos, Champion Club competition update, we are off to a slow start in 4<sup>th</sup> position with 18 species, but it is very early days. Cairns SFC have the yellow jersey. Remembers to positive id your submissions, don't just guess. Use the chat group if you need assistance.

I was recently asked the question why our ANSA QLD membership fees are higher than NSW fees. It has to do with the insurance set up. The NSW membership fee are just membership only and have no insurance component added. In ANSA QLD there is liability insurance component included. There are pros and cons for both pricing methods. Probably the biggest one is, in QLD it allows small clubs coverage at a reasonable rate.

Reminder: there are some changes to the Eligibility Species List and Trophy sizes so please just log on and have a look for yourself.

Next ANSA event is the Fishing Festival to be held a Maryborough, on the October long weekend. There are still accommodations available and cheap too. So far, the only members I know that are attending is Vaughn, Frank and myself. If you haven't fished this area before, this is a great opportunity if you need an excuse. I spoke to Dean from Maryborough Club, and he expects the fishing has been excellent in the river for King Salmon and Barra. At the end of the year, the Mary River will be a NET FREE zone.


