We fished western rocks just outside the Moreton bay for a few hours followed by some beacon bashing but honestly it was tough fishing, to my surprise we did our best on the whiting back in the bay close to Scarborough boat ramp. This is always a hot spot that my kids love.

While I haven't been offshore I've seen some huge reports of Dollie's off fads from Noosa all the way to Morton.

## December Report

### Merry Christmas Fishos

Currently we are 4th in the club challenge with 33 number of species submitted. Now is the time of year we can rack up a few of the summer pelagic species.

Kingaroy SC will be hosting the Sth Qld Interclub Challenge to be run at Bjelke-Peterson Dam. They have put together a sub-committee to organise it, so we should have more details such as accommodation options soon. This is a lovely place to visit with a great caravan park, on the edge of the dam. Also, there are plenty of wineries in the area worth a visit. This will be on the 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> April.

Shaun Manthey and I recently attended the ANSA National AGM (online). There was representative from QLD, NSW, SA, VIC and WA. There were no changes to elected positions. Nationally, last year there was 2850 members and financially they balance of \$91,000. Some of the discussion points included – a review of the rule book, branches are encouraged to ramp up support for the “Gone fishing Day” and increasing membership and participation (membership number took a dive during covid but are steadily coming back). I do have some of the reports if anyone would like them. Queensland was mentioned many times by John Burgess (the acting chair), how well QLD is going, as we have steady membership, pretty good online presences, submitting records and running regular events.

ANSA QLD (Qld Sportfishers) also had our quarterly executive committee meeting. Currently we have 450 financial members. Our discussion points included items such as finances, events, webpage support (a new site depending on funding), ANSA National conference, developing an income stream and some stuff I forgot. We will also be setting up a new system for registering for events. The plug-in we have keep breaking down and costing too much money to patch up.

Can I thank everyone that assisted in the Sportfish Challenge. I had a wonderful two days of fishing and was lucky to beat Noel Day by a whisker (and not a catfish whisker). Some very nice fish were caught and released over the two days considering the weather was not as nice as we would have liked. We are lucky to have so many options that are protected from the elements. Scott was fantastic in securing heaps of sponsors through his industry contact.

*Reminder* club record all tackle length for Bream (at time of printing ) 460mm OA

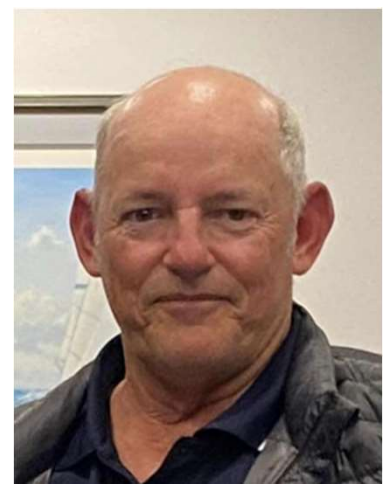
Offshore report - Everyone's waiting for the run of small blacks. Dollies being caught around the fad N/E of Hutchies and along the 80mt contour along the front of Moreton Island.

Inshore – With the recent rain , causing our rivers to be flushed try cast netting for prawns, even the small ones are great bait for Bream, threadfin, or even big snapper in the bay - run out tide works the best.

**Safety reminder** – Encouraging the adoption of good safety practices, such as wearing a lifejacket, can make a significant difference in preventing accidents and ensuring the well-being of everyone involved in water activities.

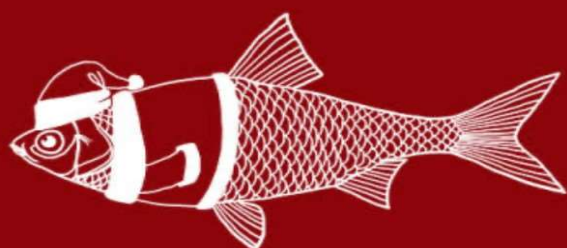
